"We're only spare parts, not the right fit for this mystery. We're a thrown out pile of warped jigsaw pieces - none of us seem to fit together. The horrors in store for us are going to get buried in the sands of time, because everyone is too distracted - political bullshit, another season to binge, or some other demonic entrapment. No one in this town will ever see or care about what we found in that storage unit out on Willow Road. That's how monsters operate. They hide inside the shadow of the world's distractions, and wait."

So writes teen-goth, Valentine Dorsey, on a clandestine, soon to be forgotten, subfeed, housed on an occulted website. Valentine accessed the website by solving a riddle from one of the unlabeled QR codes posted all around her sleepy, bordering-on-unconscious, town of Bradford Springs. On the nearly anonymous website is written, "Glimmer-Gesellschaft", which a poorly Google-translates to mean "Glimmer Society."

The QR code clearly has led to a riddle. Was it an intelligence test, or some sort of recruiting tool? Who was its creator?

16-year-old hacker and potential felon, Max Evans. A military brat, marooned at Bradford Spring's stuffy boarding school, Bradford Prep, Max is haunted by the story of six Bradford students who went missing in the 1980s, and the fact that no one on campus seems to want to talk about it. The QR code is a shot in the dark - a glimmer in the darkness.

Three individuals pass Max's test and an unlikely team is born: a near-mute goth, self-purported "witch" ostracized by her public school peers; a playboy hiding his genius out of fear of suffering the same burn-out that ruined his older brother; and a 25-year-old Lyft driver who lives in the campaign worlds of Dungeons & Dragons as much as the real world.

And then there's the storage unit filled with six mannequins, all dressed in vintage Bradford Prep school uniforms, and each with curving metal hooks for heads. Valentine is right. They're not the right ones for this mystery. But they're the only ones who notice something is terribly wrong in Bradford Springs.



Described by creators Jamie Potter and Klaus as Dungeons & Demons™, Glimmer Society resonates with every teen subsisting on the fringes of their hometown world, who feel pulled towards the secrets beyond life's physical veil. Glimmer Society finds Potter and Klaus threading a heart-racing thriller with dynamic characters and villains so dark they will choke the breath from readers' lungs the moment they appear on the page and burrow into the readers' minds.







VALENTINE

Valentine wasn't always a near-mute goth, drifting through the hallways of the local high school that Bradford Prep students throw crushed beer cans at. There was a time when she had sleepovers, went to soccer practice, and loved her adopted family and her step-sister Ellie. Then, when Valentine had just turned ten, August 7th happened. Playing outside with Ellie, an unbridled rage overcame Valentine as the two sisters fought over a petty disagreement. Screaming, Valentine reached out her hand; a wild wind swept up, lifting Ellie ten feet off the ground and impaling her on a broken tree limb. From that day on, Valentine became a shell, a living zombie going through the motions. Discovering Max's QR code riddle on a bus seat going to get prescription meds for her dying adopted father, Valentine feels awake and alive for the first time in years. Her interest becomes obsession: if she can find what happened to the missing Bradford Prep teens, she can redeem herself. The only problem? Her telekinetic powers that have lain dormant for six years are about to explode.

Hacker extraordinaire, more comfortable behind a computer screen or a microphone with his post-punk, electronica band, Max Evans wears the title "hero" as uncomfortably as a sandpaper straightjacket. With a mother who has passed recently, and a distant father stationed in the military, Max is an island all to himself. But not for long. Thinking his stuffy prep school is just a country club for rich elites, he's surprised when he uncovers clues about a secret club in the 1980s called the Glimmer Society, and even more shocked when he learns that all eight members went missing. When no one at school seems to care about the eight teens' disappearance, Max puts up a flyer with a QR code around the town of Bradford Springs. His hope is that someone will solve the QR code's riddle, find the true crime website he's set up, and help him crack the case. The only distraction holding him back? Max can't stop dreaming about a basement and a giant wearing a metal horned mask who seems to be constructing a suit of armor made out of bones.



On the surface, Ridgewood is a playboy and a great athlete who runs with the incrowd at Bradford Prep. Who he is in his heart of hearts couldn't be farther from the truth: he's a genius, one of the nation's best college prospects. What holds Ridgewood back is the fear that what happened to his older brother who went to Harvard and had a mental breakdown, might happen to him. At first, Ridgewood is an unlikely candidate for Max's secret society. A year back, Ridgewood publicly humiliated Max at a school dance, and their interactions have been icy ever since. Easily acing all his tests at school, Ridgewood answers the QR code riddle to keep from dying of boredom. Little does he know, Max is the riddle's creator. When things gets dark and deadly, Max and Ridgewood must put aside their differences to become allies for a greater cause.



Best friend of Ridgewood, Topher is a fourth generation Bradford Prep poster boy: handsome, athletic, violent and withdrawn, he's a shark in a pool of minnows. He also helped humiliate Max at a school dance, though, unlike Ridgewood, Topher had a change of heart after overhearing a horrible phone conversation between Max and his father. Maybe Topher's change has something to do with the great secret he keeps, a secret that lives in a padlocked box under his bed. Topher is the keeper of a family relic that happens to be part of a family member's body. His uncle's zombie hands. Topher discovers that he can actually control the hands, use them as secondary appendages and ultimately, as weapons when a monster comes to call.






Swedish exchange student Oona is a bold challenge to the Puritanism of Bradford Springs. Smart, unabashedly sexy, Oona is a fantasy for both boys and girls at Bradford Prep. No one knows that this cover story acts as armor for Oona. Her real story is that she has a split personality that actually splits from her: she sees her double every day, walking the halls, setting Oona up for disasters that Oona finds herself participating in against her will. It's actually Oona's double that finds the QR code and brings the challenge to Oona, a peace offering, something they can work on together. Little does Oona know that her double is waiting for the right time to sabotage everything and deliver Oona to the demon reawakening in Bradford Springs.



Tessa arrives mid-semester at Bradford Springs, one of the last members to join the Glimmer Society. The offspring of Brazilian and Greek parents, Tessa is a child of nature—semi-feral, unconcerned with superficial looks, allergic to wearing shoes. She needs to feel the ground beneath her feet at all times. She has the soul of an ancient shaman that is ill-suited for 21st century American consumerism. What Tessa lacks in verbal input, her grounding in nature makes her an invaluable asset to the evolving team as they dig up clues and follow leads. Though an old soul, Tessa is too trusting; her willingness to accept the balance of good and evil in the world makes her body vulnerable, even if her spirit soars above the fray. She strolls barefooted into the path of a demon and killer, and doesn't blink when she locks eyes with them: they've done this dance before. But who will walk away?

Aguirre-Sarcasa and Francavilla, Volume One, 2016, ISBN:1627383719)



Bardugo gives a master class in world-building, taking her own personal experience and understanding of the New Haven landscape and history from being a student at Yale, and extrapolates a new realm of wonder.
